

The National Junior Honor Society recognizes outstanding Middle School students who demonstrate excellence in the areas of Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Character. These characteristics have been associated with membership in the organization since its beginning in 1912.

National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) is an organization that has been active in Albion for many years. Students can qualify as either a 7th grader or as an 8th grader. Academically, students must have a 93% cumulative average for their last 4 quarters (1st 2 this year and last 2 last year), and no quarter can be below 90%. Students that meet these academic requirements are invited to support their candidacy for membership. This consists of completing an application, writing an essay, and obtaining three letters of recommendation. Membership is granted only to those selected by the Albion NJHS Faculty Council using the information provided by the candidates in the areas of leadership, service, and character as well as input gathered from the Albion Middle School faculty, staff, and administration.
